CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

For 15 teaching positions at the National Advanced School of Public Works (NASPW)

In accordance with the instructions of the **President of the Republic, Head of State**, and following press release N°25-00116/MINESUP/DDES/CEPE of 7 April 2025 by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education, relating to the authorization to open teaching positions, the Director of the National Advanced School of Public Works (NASPW) hereby informs the general public that fifteen (15) teaching positions are open for recruitment in this institution of higher learning with special status, for the year 2025, to persons of Cameroonian nationality, aged at most 45 years on 1st October 2025 and holders of a Doctorat or PhD.

Interested candidates are invited to submit a complete file to the mail service at the Head Office of National Advanced School of Public Works (NASPW) located at Elig-Effa Yaounde no later than 13 June 2025 at 3.30 p.m. strict deadline.

Candidates residing abroad shall submit their application to diplomatic missions and consular services, no later than 6 June 2025.

The application file shall include the following documents:

1. A stamped application not older than three (3) months, addressed to the Director of NASPW;
2. A certified true photocopy of the birth certificate dated less than three (3) months;
3. A detailed and signed Curriculum Vitae;
4. Certified photocopies of all diplomas obtained from the Baccalaureat or GCE Advanced Level;
5. A copy of the Doctorate or PhD thesis;
6. Copies of articles or off prints of any publications, where necessary;
7. A medical certificate issued within the last three (3) months and by a medical doctor in the public health sector;

8. Four (4) passport size photographs (colour);
9. A photocopy of the valid National Identity Card;
10. A certificate of non -conviction issued within the last three (3) months;
11. An attestation of service as permanent lecturer in the home university, duly signed by a competent authority, for candidates for the rank of Lecturer, Associate Professor and Professor;
12. A certificate of nationality and/or, for candidates living abroad, photocopies of the passports and residence permits certified by the Cameroonian consular services;
13. A certificate of effective presence duly signed by a competent authority (for applicants with a job);
14. A prior authorization from the user Minister or the head of the home administration (for applicants with a job);
15. A copy of the National Disability Card (for disabled persons);
16. An undertaking on (i) the authenticity of the documents provided, (ii) the effective availability of the candidate and, for candidates living abroad, (iii) the non – existence of any situation likely to expose the applicant to a double salary.

Any application that is incomplete or submitted after the deadline shall be rejected.
